Dateline: WASHINGTON A Pennsylvania company has recalled 845 pounds of smoked salmon and 144 pounds of smoked trout, citing the potential for listeria contamination.

MacKnight Smoked Foods of New Britain, Pa., said Tuesday that the recalled Long Sliced Smoked Salmon was distributed in Missouri, New Jersey, Texas, New Mexico, Kansas, Georgia, Louisiana and Colorado through retail stores. The Long Sliced Smoked Trout was distributed in New Jersey through retail stores.
